#### for Monday, October 20

Section 14.4 on pages 237 to 250. Note that the verbal procedure in Section 14.4 is rather neatly summarized in the box on page 250.

Only a quick reading of 14.5 on page 252 is needed.

Look at problems 1 to 5 and 7 in Exercise Set D on pages 250 and 251. Problems 3 and 4 are the key problems.

Look at Review Problems 7 and 8 on page 253. (Both are critically important.)

*Extra Problem:* The unconditional probability of event A is  $1/2$ . The unconditional probability of event B is  $1/3$ .

Find the chance that at least one of them happens,

1. if A and B are mutually exclusive.
2. if A and B are independent.
